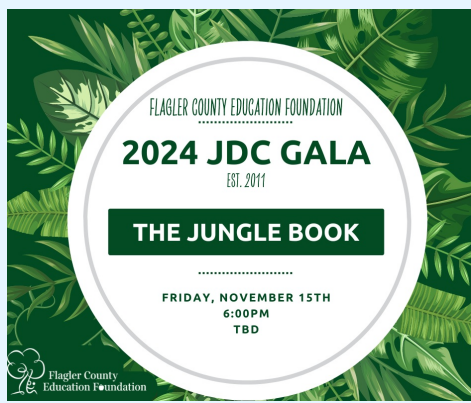


STUFF Bus Packing Event
