The largest was a \$190,000 Resiliency Through Community Partners grant through the Consortium of Florida Education Foundations and the Florida Department of Health to provide clinical mental health services to Flagler County students.

Also during the spotlight, Heidi Alves, the district's Teaching and Learning science specialist, accepted a check for \$11,024 from Florida Power and Light for Empowering STEM Educators.
